MAGNET RECOGNITION

The Nursing Division at The Western Pennsylvania Hospital applied for Magnet Recognition in 2005 from the credentialing organization of the American Nurses Association, the ANCC. The Magnet Recognition Program recognizes excellence in nursing services and the continued encouragement and support of staff nurses. The ANCC has recognized health care organizations all over the world. Of the 6,000 organizations in the U.S., only about 4% have achieved Magnet Recognition. The Western Pennsylvania Hospital achieved Magnet Recognition in December 2006.
