This is typically completed on or around July 1. The Clarion University Council of Trustees sets fees which are used to support student activities and the operation of university facilities. All fees are payable whether or not the student plans to use these services or facilities.

## **Explanation of Fees**

Clarion University Fees				
Technology Fee:	Charged each semester to each student in order: (1) to acquire, install and maintain up-to-date and emerging technologies for the purpose of enhancing student-learning outcomes; (2) to provide equitable access to technology resources, and; (3) to ensure, ultimately, that state system graduates are competitive in the technology-sophisticated workplace.			
Instructional Support Fee:	charged each semester to each student in order to upgrade instructional equipment, improve library holdings, and for other instructional purposes.			
Student Support Fee:	charged each semester to Venango College students to cover the cost of student support services provided at Venango College.			
Records Fee:	charged to all students during their first semester as an undergraduate and as a graduate. This fee entitles the student to free transcripts for life and covers the cost of commencement and printing of diplomas.			
STEM Fee:	students in science, technology, mathematics, and health (STEM-H) related courses – in which a lab, fieldwork, or clinical experience is required.

Technology Fee:	to maintain upkeep and usage of computer resources (\$30 first year only - first term at WPHSON)			
Administrative Fee	record keeping and assessment, student handbooks, orientation material, transcripts, etc. (\$100 per year-first term at WPHSON and 2nd AY - Fall term)			
Laboratory Fee:	student lab supplies (gloves, gowns, IV catheters, IV tubing, etc.) for clinical learning lab activities. (\$150 first term at WPHSON)			
STAR Fee:	simulation activities in the STAR center including use of lab space, mannequins and supplies. (\$250 each academic year - first term at WPHSON, 2nd AY-Fall Term)			
ATI Course Support and Testing Fee:	includes standardized testing across the curriculum, online study and review modules, remediation activities, and correspondence associated with testing packages. (\$1325 per AY - \$662.50 first term, \$662.50 third term)			
Graduation Fee:	cost of graduation pin and engraving, diplomas, covers, and graduation festivities. (\$275 last term)
